Last day for donations at St Andrew's West Linton will be **Sunday 17 November**


ADVENT STUDIES

Harvest thanksgiving service led by Rev Dr Tony Foley 10am to 10.45am Please come if you can – we would be delighted to see you!




Harvest donations!
