

### Can you help re-open West Linton Post Office?

You may have read in the Peeblesshire News about a fundraising campaign, I'm including it here for those not on social media. Some will know Susan from her regular vistis to West Linton with The Allotment pop up fruit & veg shop, some will remember her father Reid Meikle or her grandfather Jock Meikle the policeman.

My name is Susan Meikle, I am asking for community help to fund the reinstatement West Linton Post Office.

The closure of West Linton Post Office has left a void in the community, and many residents are feeling the impact, especially those lacking alternative transportation options.

A Post Office serves as more than just a point for transactions; it is a gathering space for locals, a hub for vital information, and an essential resource for delivering packages, accessing postal and banking services.

Unfortunately, when the West Linton Post Office closed, Post Office Ltd removed all the equipment and disconnected all utilities, stating they were tied to the previous post mistress's contract and cannot be reassigned to another post master. This leaves a situation whereby any incoming post master will be required to finance the purchase of new equipment, signage and reconnection of utilities themselves. Post Office Ltd is advising there is no funding available for this.

Post Office counters are reliant on host retail premises and it is my intention to open The Allotment West Linton in the building, and as such, will be bearing all costs of this. The landlords are very kindly bearing the cost of refurbishing their premises to allow this to take place. I just need help with the Post Office part.:)

They anticipate around 120 nomination from social work, schools and health visitors to help families across Peeblesshire and hope we can help in some small way.




